Engage

- 1. Read Psalm 127:3-5; 2 John 1:4
 - What is a "heritage" and how does this language give unique value to children?
 - Why is it crucial to understand that your children exist for God and not you?
- 2. Read Deuteronomy 6:6-9; 2 Timothy 3:14-15
 - How does Scripture warn against passive parenting?
 - What is our main source and guide for leading/influencing our children?
- 3. Read Hebrews 12:6, 11; Proverbs 23:12-16
 - What is the difference between discipline and punishment?
 - Why does the Bible associate discipline with love?

Apply

- 1. Why is it so important to model following Jesus for your children?
- 2. What are some things that compete for the place parenting should have in our hearts?
- 3. What do you hope your children say about you and your parenting in 10 years?
- 4. For those who do not have children of your own at home, what can you do to promote a healthy view of children in the church?

Take some time to pray individually to God that you would view children and parenting as a good gift from Him. Have the group leader close the prayer time by asking God for help as we learn to teach our children the truth and discipline them in love.
